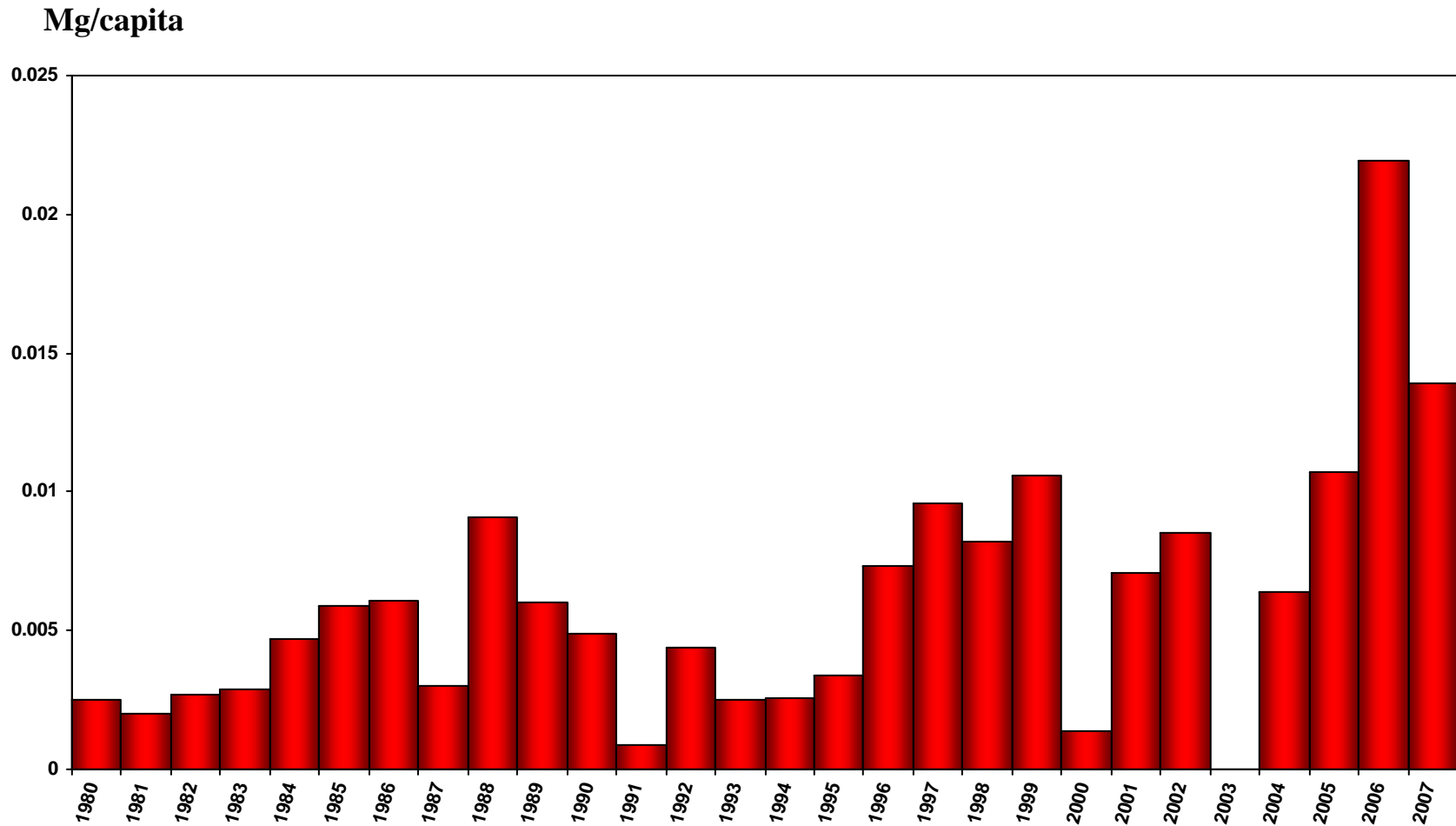
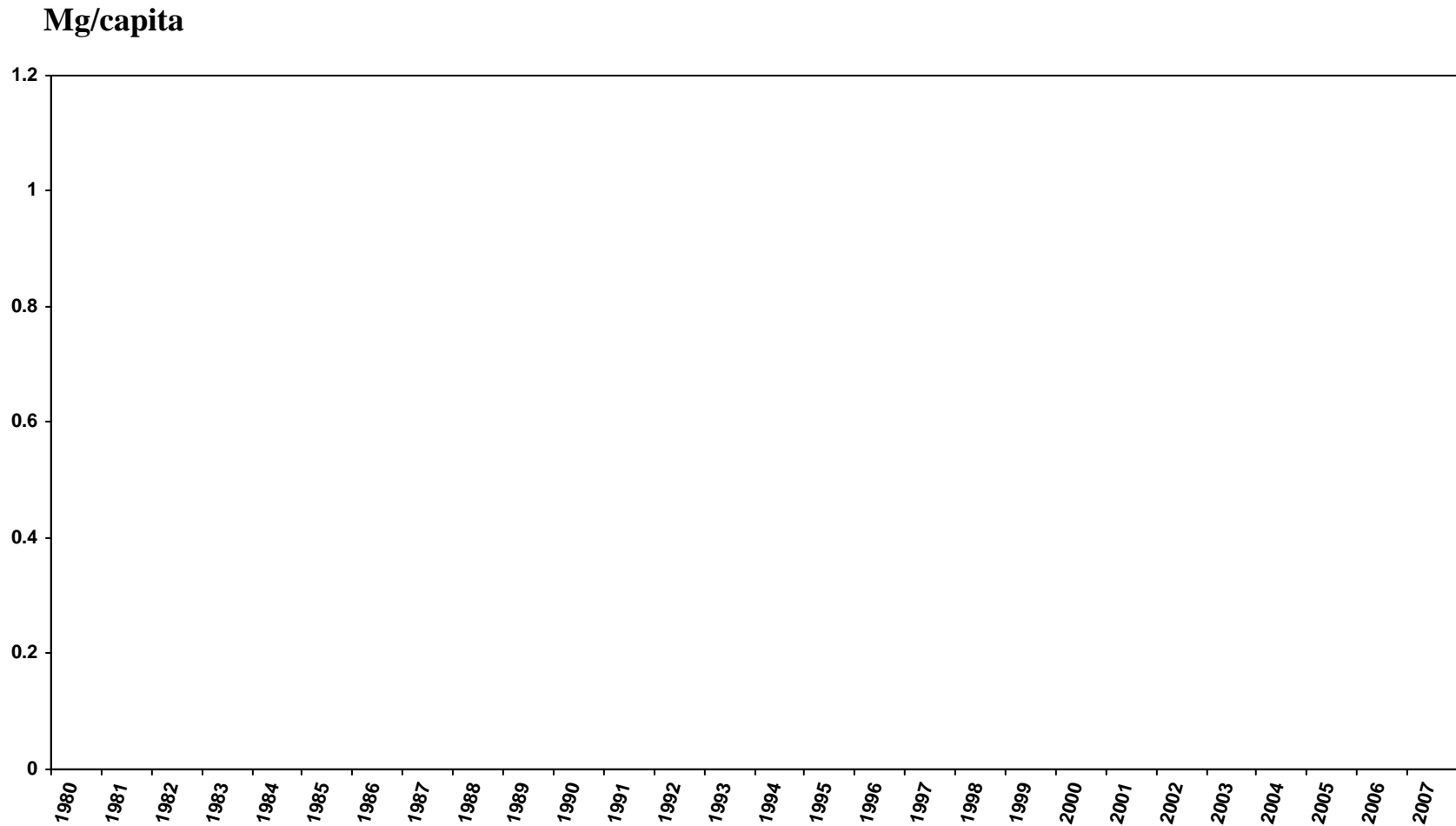


# Mg/capita Consumption of Fentanyl, Cuba, 1980-2007



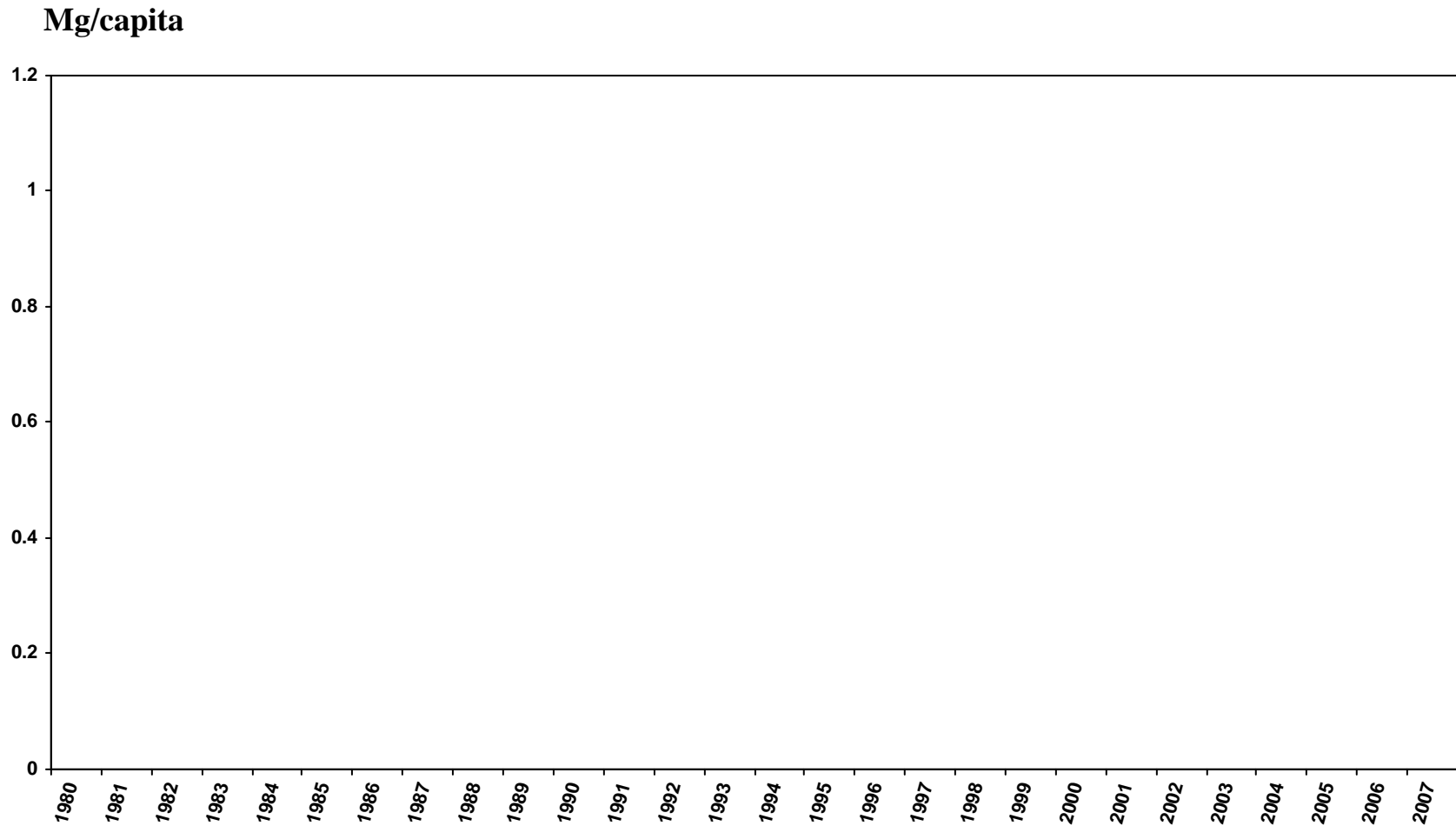

# Mg/capita Consumption of Hydromorphone, Cuba, 1980-2007



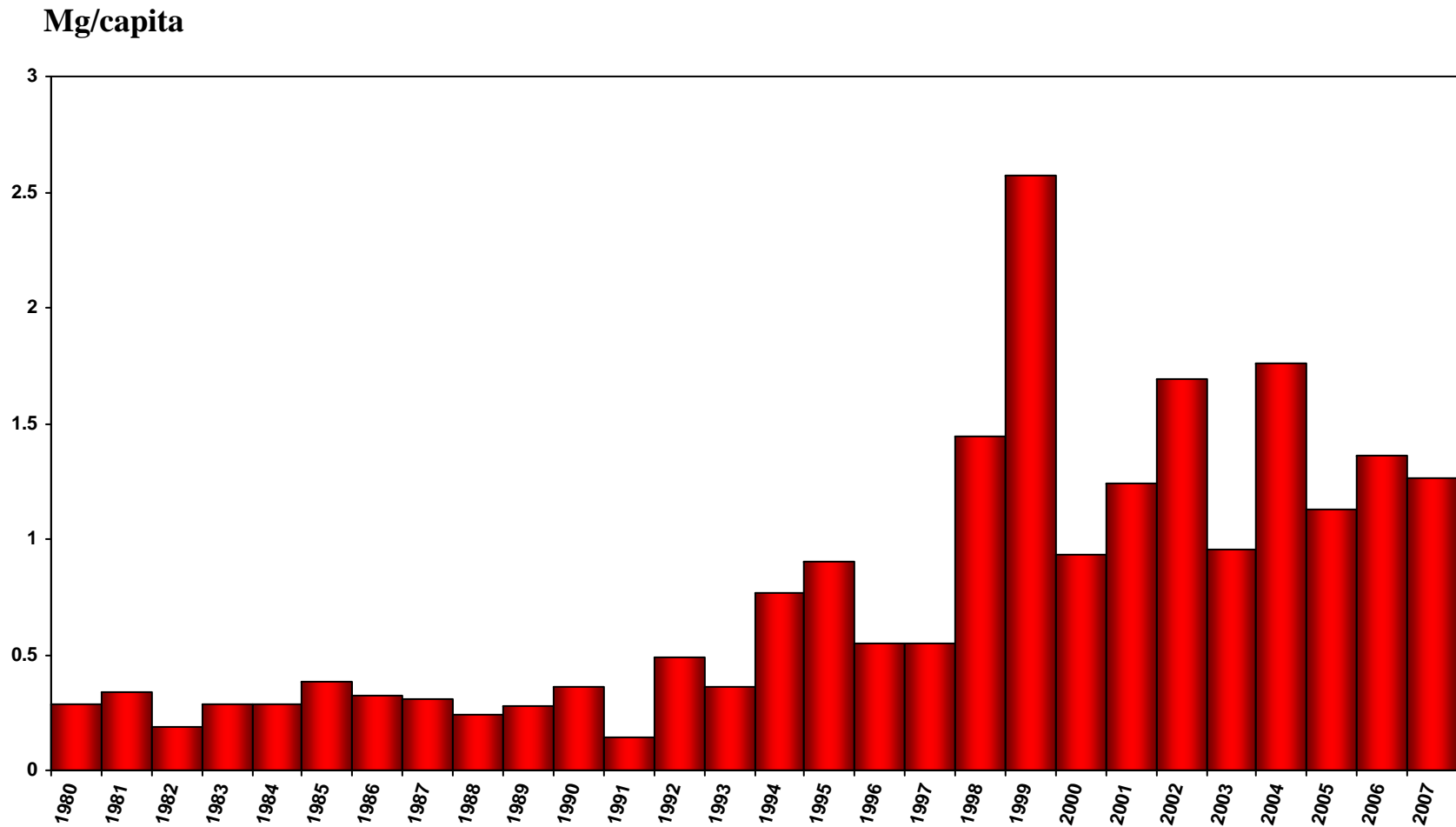

# Mg/capita Consumption of Methadone, Cuba, 1980-2007



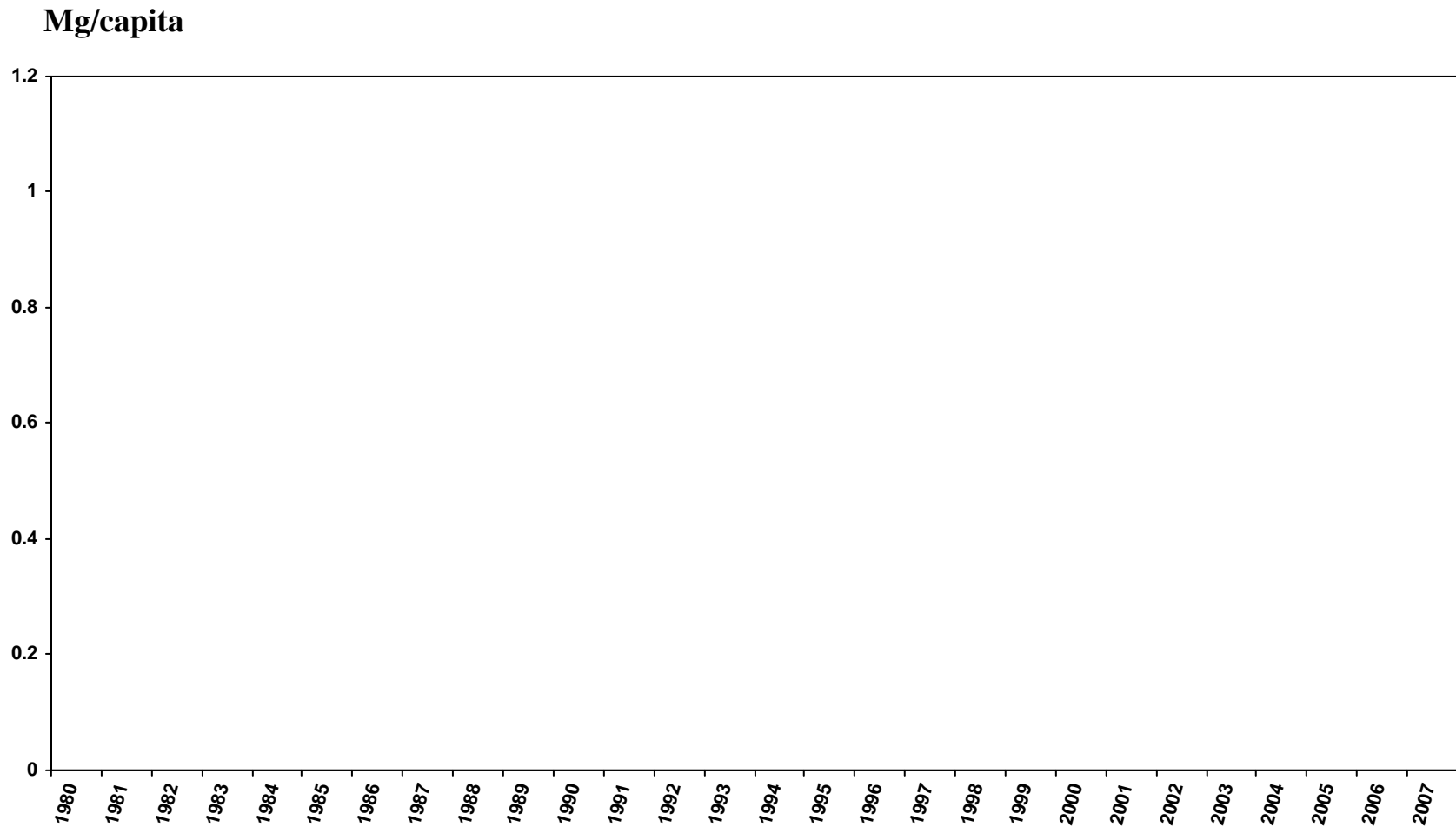

# Mg/capita Consumption of Morphine, Cuba, 1980-2007



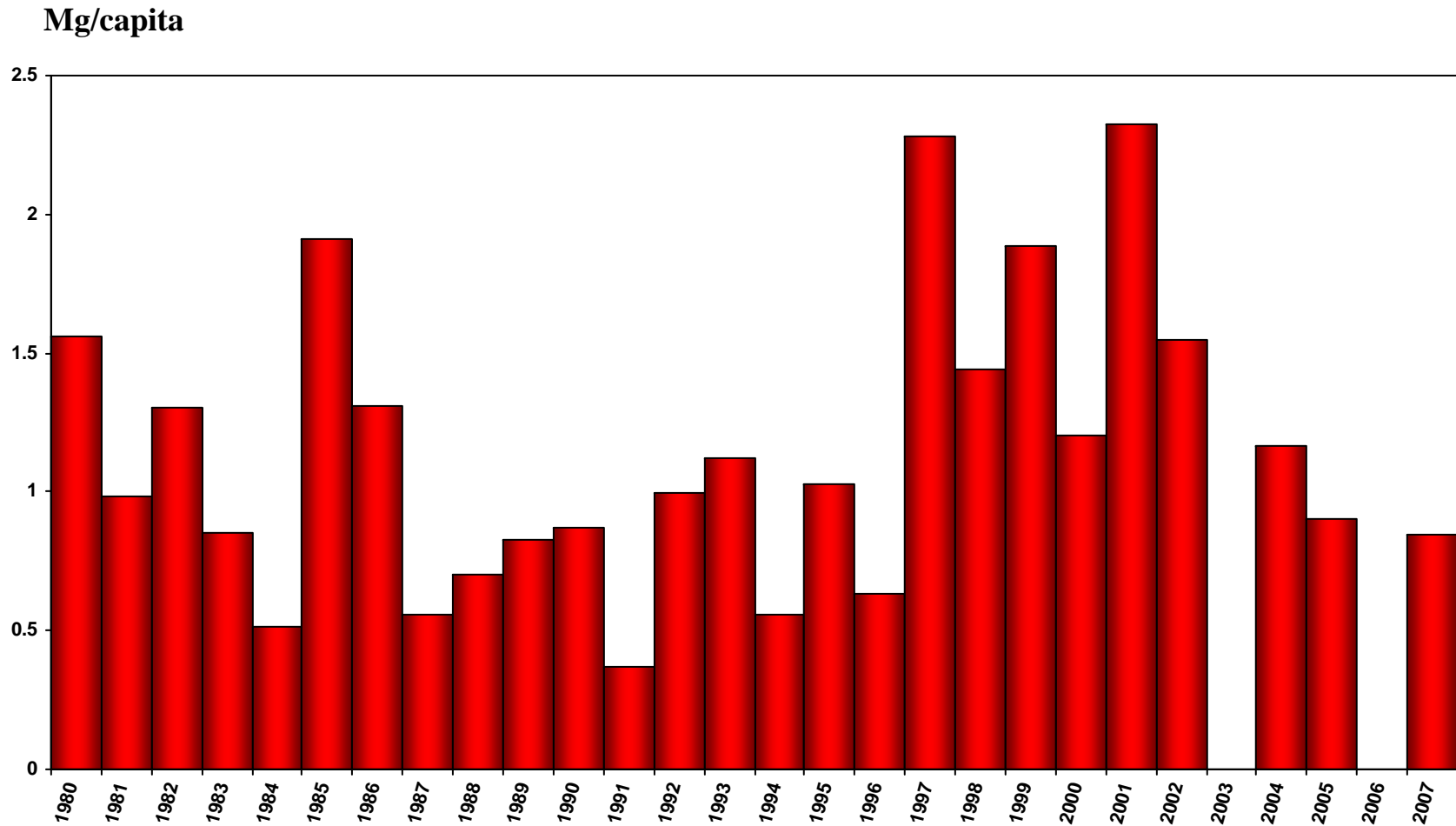
