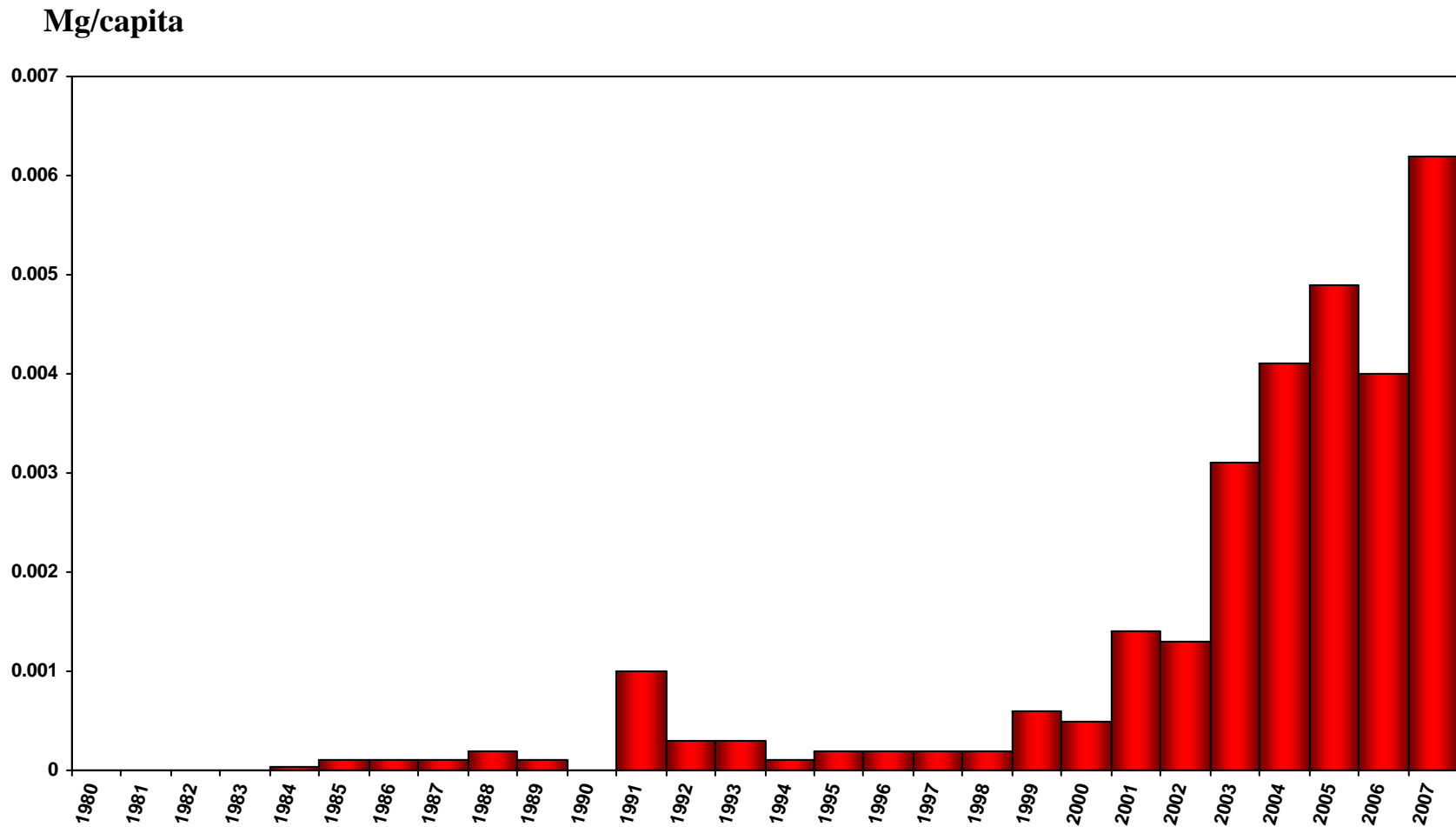
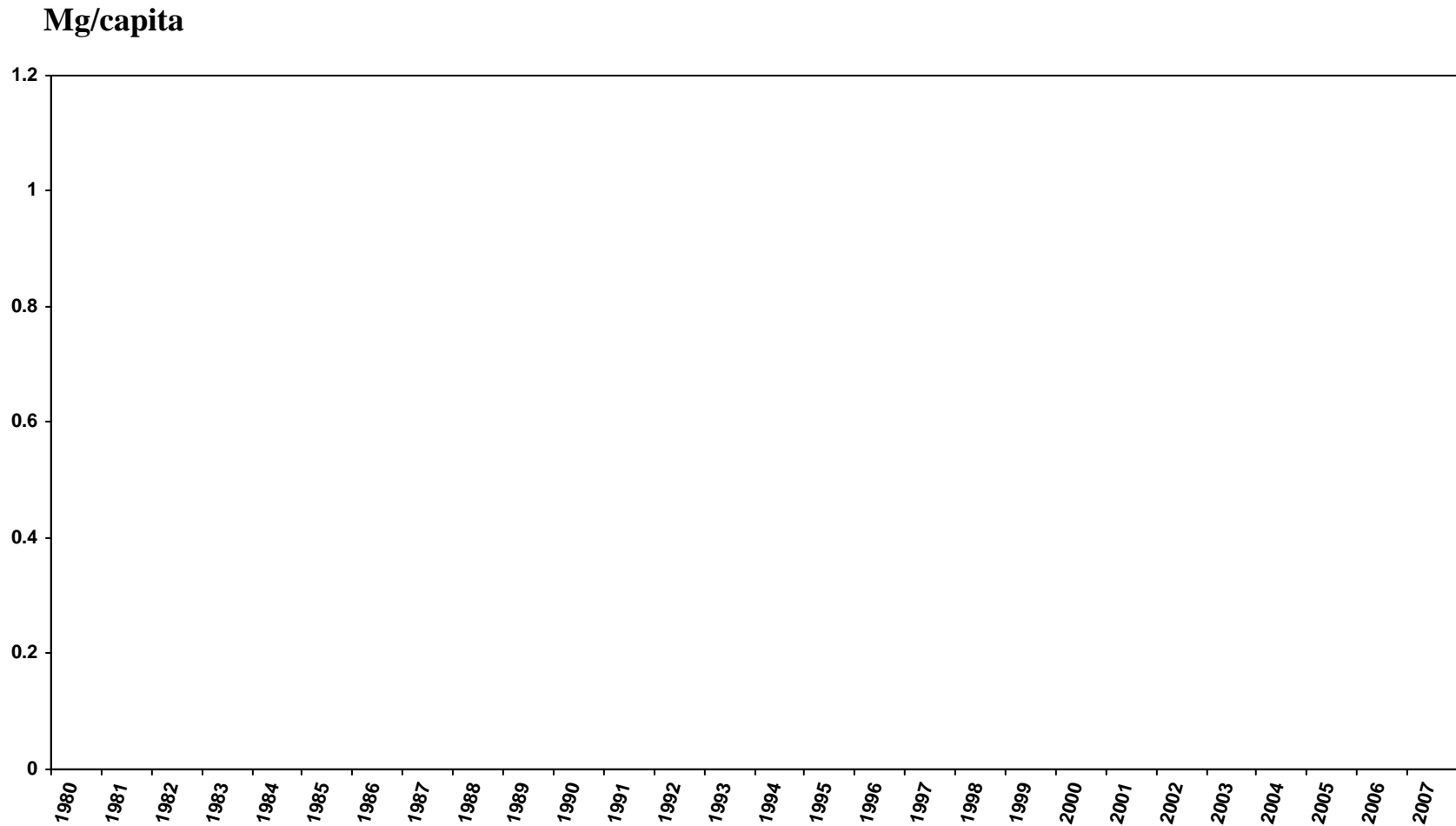


# Mg/capita Consumption of Fentanyl, China, 1980-2007



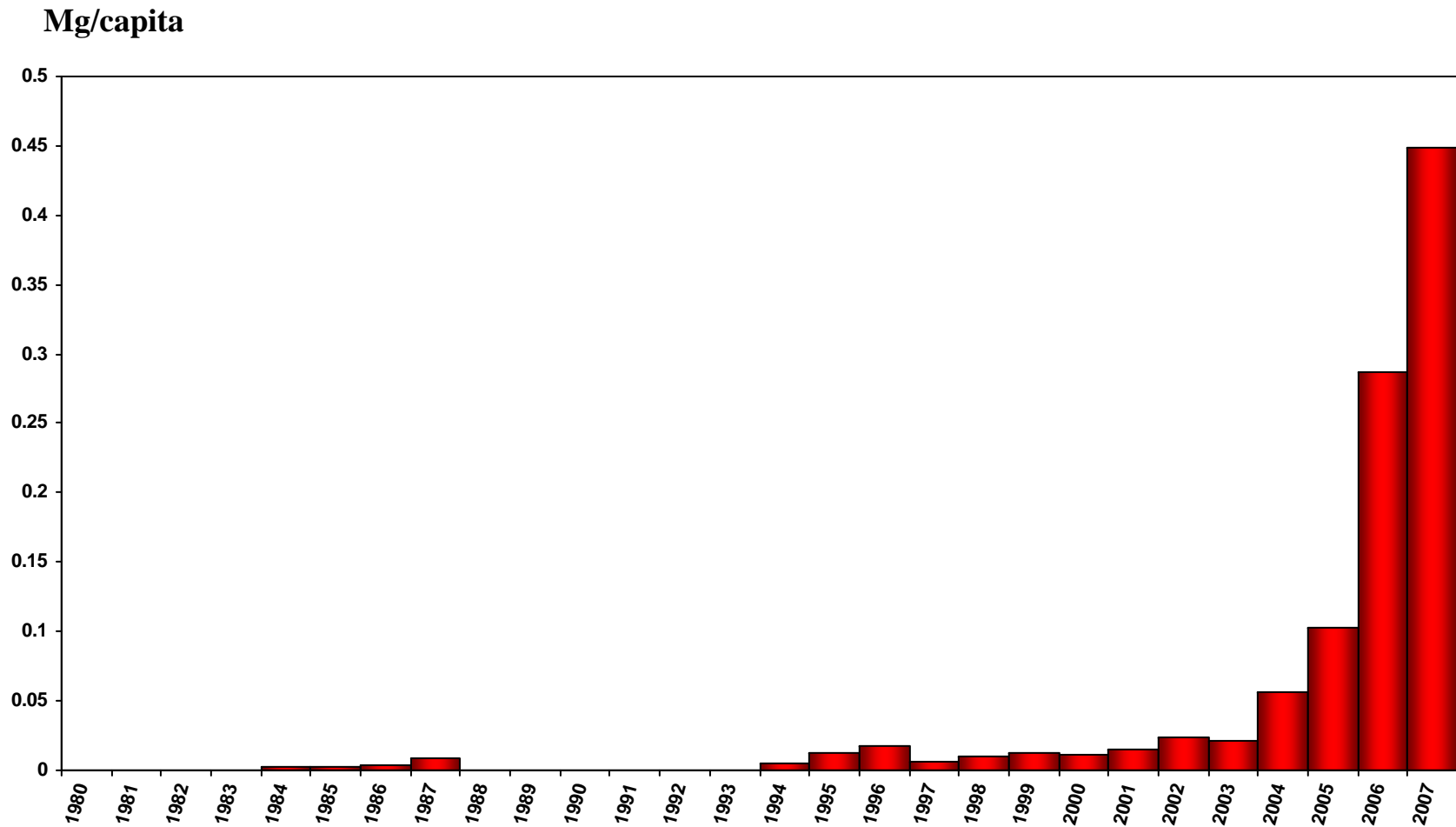

# Mg/capita Consumption of Hydromorphone, China, 1980-2007



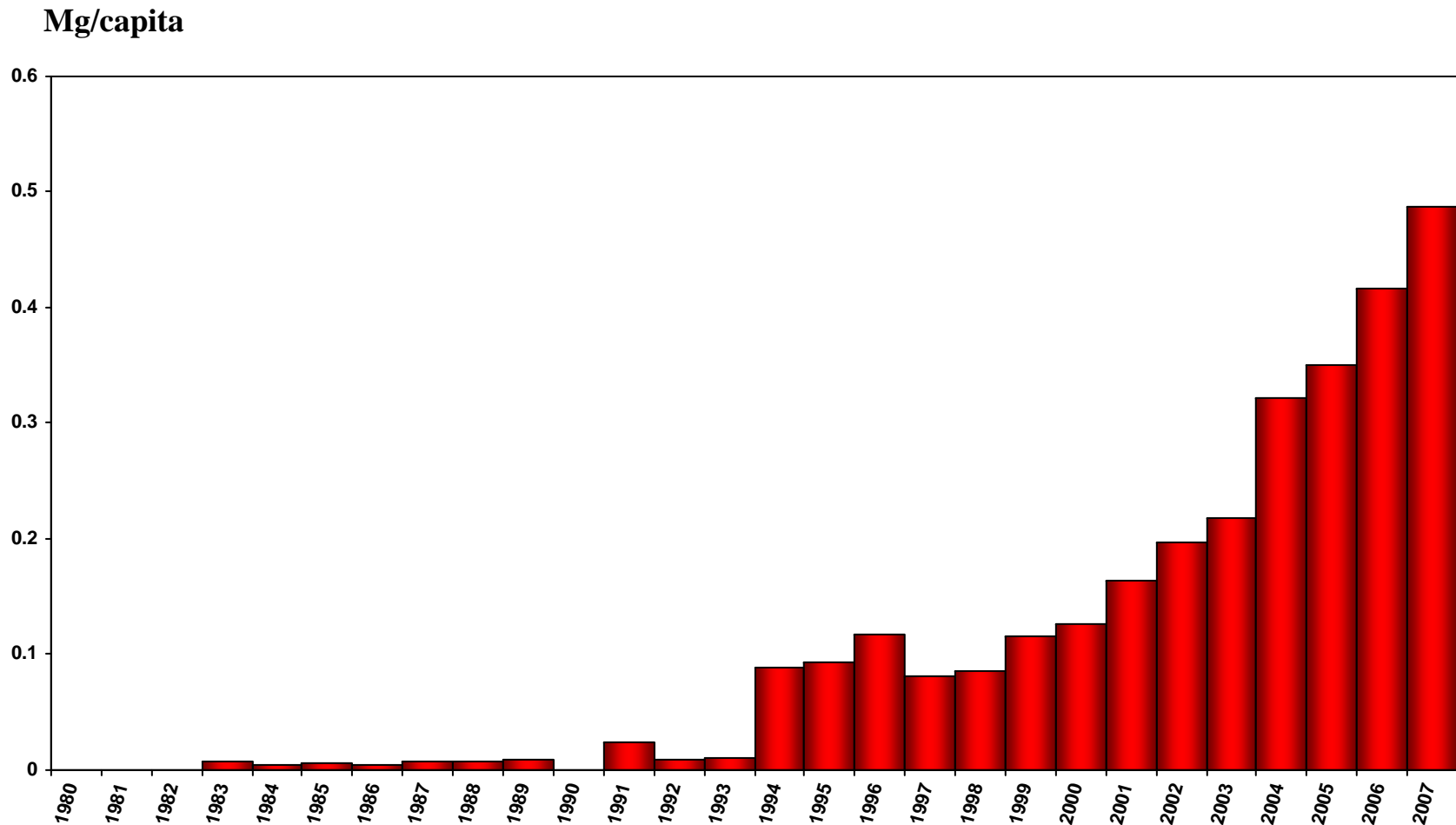

# Mg/capita Consumption of Methadone, China, 1980-2007



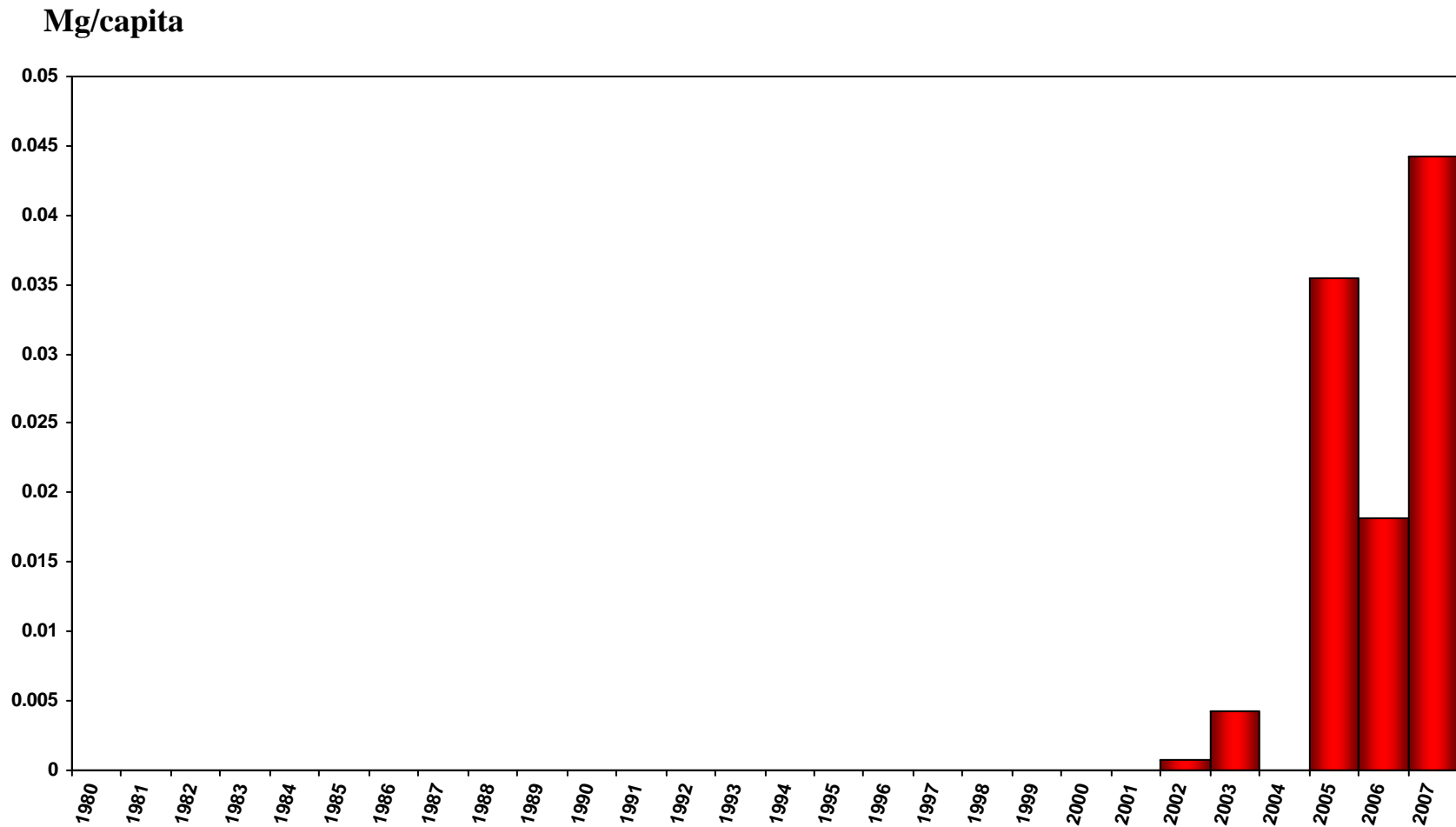

# Mg/capita Consumption of Morphine, China, 1980-2007



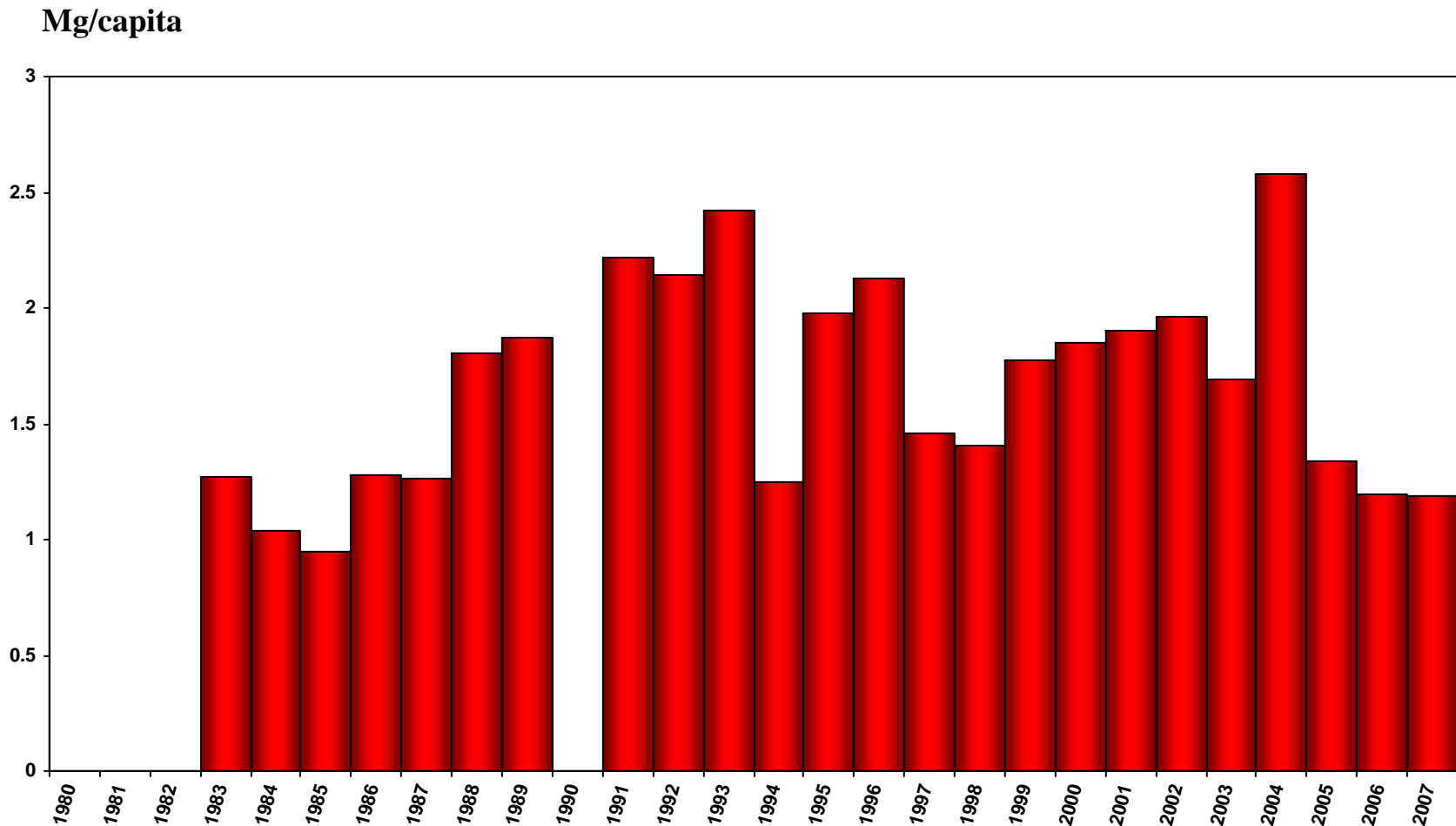
