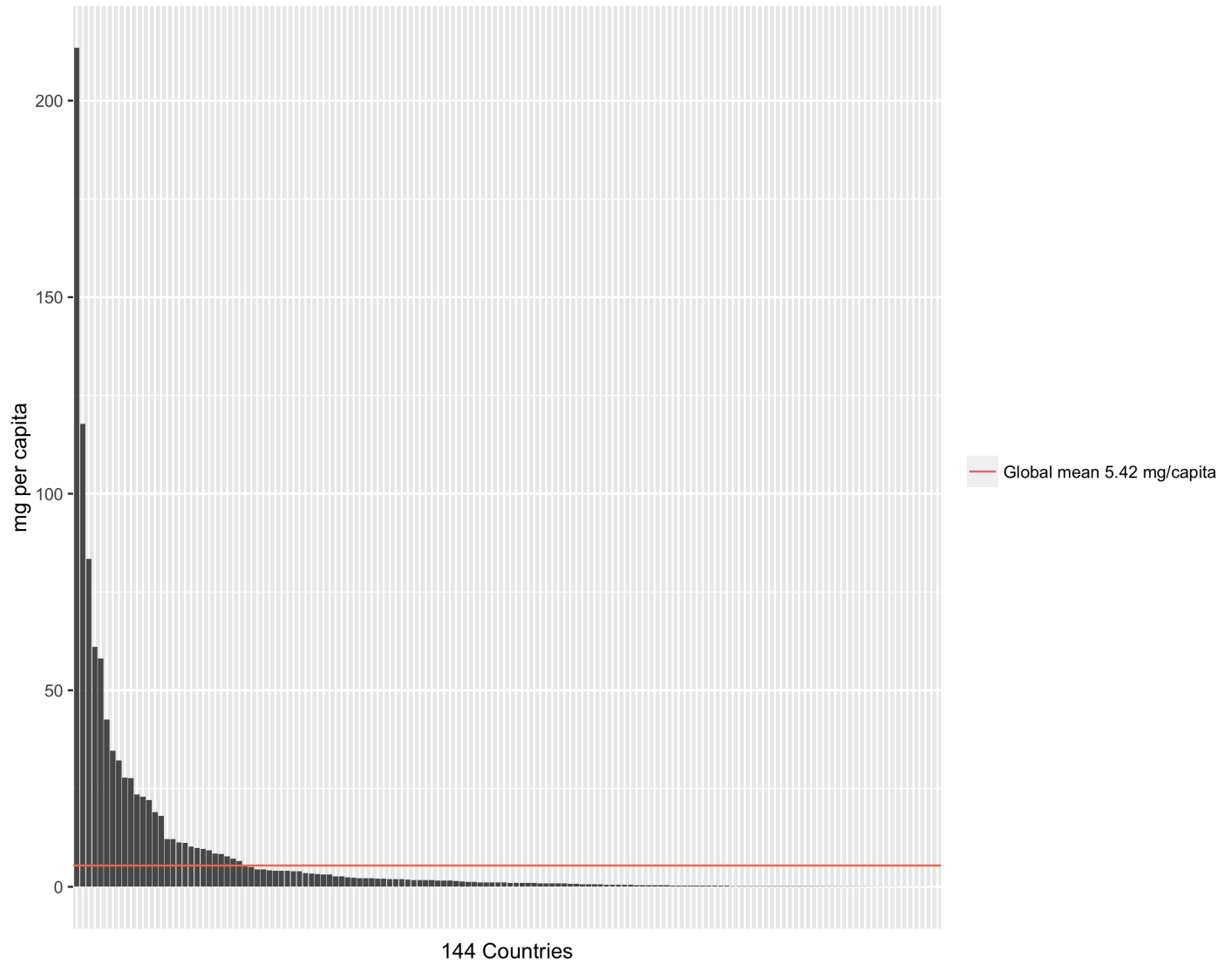


# 2015 Global Consumption of Morphine (mg/capita)
