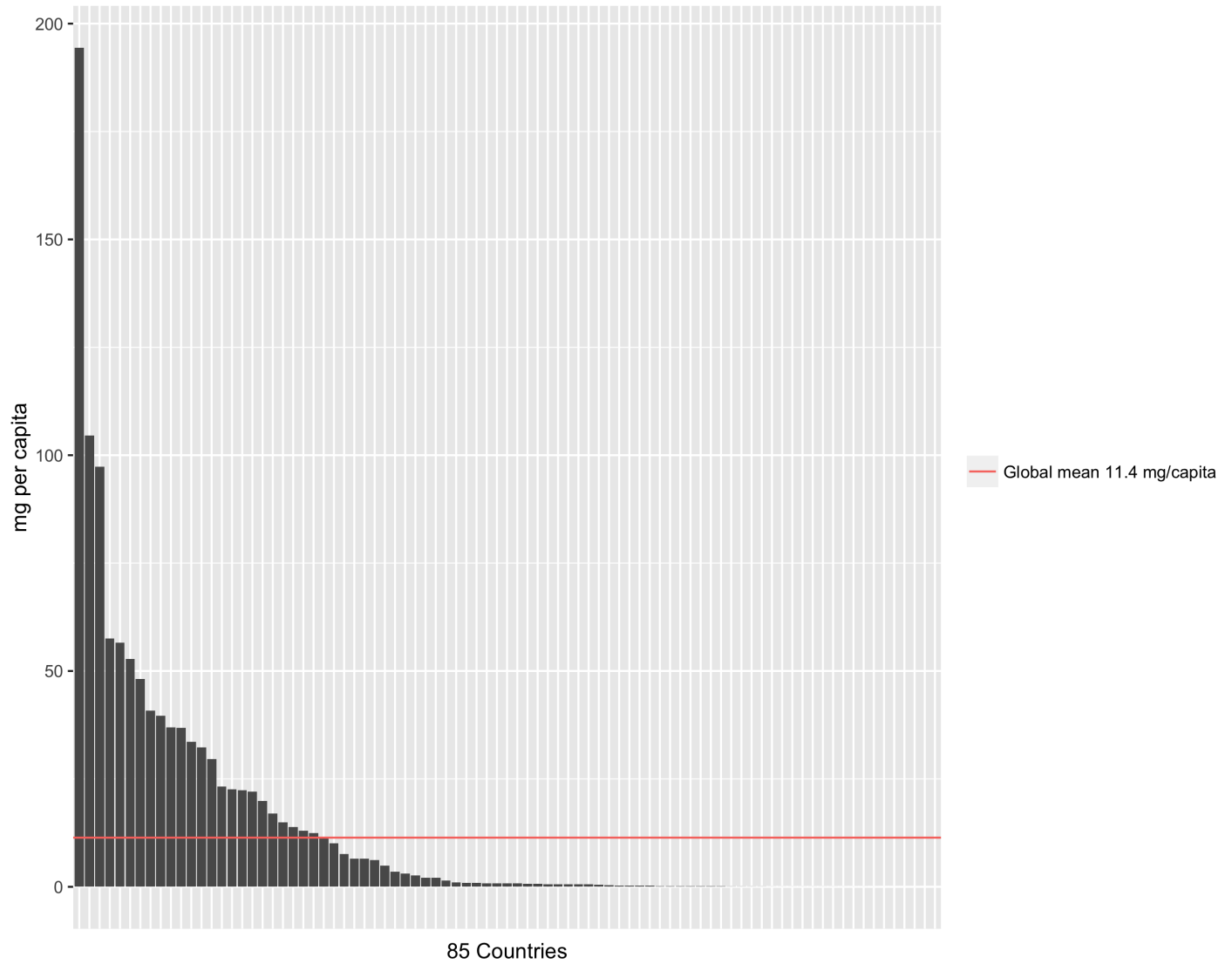


2015 Global Consumption of Oxycodone (mg/capita)
